(1) Traveling, dining out and hospitality have been synonymous with Japanese culture for many centuries, resulting in the modern-day hotel industry putting more priority on providing dining choices to their guests than anything else.

It would not be far off to say that virtually all international hotels in Japan are rooms and meeting halls built around (1) and kitchens.

Every name hotel in the country has several restaurants on its premises^{*1}; some have as many as a dozen restaurants, each offering a different kind of cuisine^{*2} and service. I dare say there is (2) a major hotel in Japan that does not have at least an American style restaurant, a Chinese restaurant, and a Japanese restaurant. Many also have French restaurants.

Hotel dining is not (3) to hotel guests. Huge numbers of local residents, Japanese and foreign, regularly dine in hotel restaurants. Some hotel restaurants enjoy a cachet^{*3} of their own, having become the place to dine when one is out, and the place to see and be seen.

Many of these hotels employ the most skilled chefs in the world, and their restaurants are known internationally for the gourmet quality of their food. These hotels are lavish^{*4} in their efforts to create an extraordinary dining experience.

(2) Hotel coffee shops in Japan (as in other countries) serve a special purpose and deserve special mention. (4) the convenience they offer to hotel guests, they are the place that guests and outsiders go to when they want a “standard” breakfast, lunch or dinner at prices that are generally below those of the in-house Japanese, international and ethnic restaurants.

In this case, “standard” coffee shop meals in international hotels generally consist primarily of American/Western style dishes. Some coffee shops, (5), also offer a limited number of typical Japanese breakfast, lunch and dinner choices.
